<b>50 JR 4-6 / 50 SR 7-8</b> (0-51cc)	<b>Open A / Open B / Open C</b> (122cc-Open, 14 and up)
<b>65 JR 7-9 / 65 SR 10-11</b> (59-65cc)	<b>25+</b> (122-Open, 25 and up)
<b>85 JR 9-11 / 85 SR 12-15</b> (79-85cc)	<b>30+ A / 30+ B/C</b> (122cc – Open, 30 and up)
<b>125cc</b> (122-125cc, 12 and up)	<b>40+</b> (122cc – Open, 40 and up)
<b>Women</b> (99cc – 250cc, 12 and up, no minicycles)	<b>4 wheel A / 4 wheel B / 4 wheel C</b> (91cc-Open, 16 & up)

\* Not all AMA D-17 classes will be run as this is a limited class event, only the classes listed above will be run.

**Racer Information**

4:00 pm      **Pits open** – Use SE entrance to fairgrounds, parking personnel can direct you back to the pit area.  
4 - 5:30 pm      **Sign-up** – Located in the Pit area. **AMA & District membership required. Can purchase at track.**  
5:45 pm      **Riders Meeting** / Door prizes  
6:00 pm      **Practice**      7 - 10 pm      **Races**

Registration fee is \$25 per class.      Pit Fee: \$10 adult and \$5 for 12 & under  
Grandstand spectator fee: \$8 adult and \$4 for 12 & under

2 Moto format – cash payback for 250A, Open A & 4 wheel A is 125% payback / 25+, 30+A & 40+ 75% per moto finish.  
Youth classes - 100% Trophy payback

Track will be in the grandstand area and feature a rubber-band start, doubles, tabletops, whoops and mostly flat corners.

Race order will be determined based on # of riders in each class. Classes may be combined and run together (but will be scored separately for trophies / cash awards). If a class is too large to run all at once, it will be split up into 2 or more classes (Ex. 250 C could be split up into 2 classes – 250 C-1 and 250 C-2 and scored individually for awards and points).

**DIRECTIONS TO THE GEORGETOWN FAIR: 413 N. Seminary Georgetown, IL. 61846**

The Georgetown, IL Fairgrounds are very easy to find once you arrive in Georgetown and signs will be posted. The fairgrounds are located less than a mile East off of Georgetown Rd (Route 1) on Mill Street.

**From Illinois:**

Interstate 74 to Danville, IL Exit 215A (Rt. 1 / Georgetown Rd)  
South on Illinois Route 1 to Georgetown, IL  
Once arrive in Georgetown, take a left (East) at 1<sup>st</sup> stoplight (Mill Street)  
Fairgrounds will be on your left in less than one mile

**From Indiana:**

Highway 63 to Cayuga, IN (Hwy 234)  
Travel West on Highway 234 (turns into Mill Street) approximately 11 miles to Georgetown Fairgrounds  
Look for signs - fairgrounds will be on your right
